- 1. Play-offs for the C division:
 - 1. Playoff structure in the C-division will be divided into three separate playoff groups Championship Playoff, Ranking Playoff and Participation Playoff
 - 2. C-division Championship playoff For 2025:
 - 1. Will be comprised of 8 teams
 - 2. From the three groups top two finishers in group automatically make it to Championship playoffs
 - 3. All 19 teams from C Division will be ranked from 1-19 based on points and NRR this will be their PLAYOFF SEED.
 - 4. The two highest seeded remaining teams based on their PLAYOFF SEED (other than the 6 that automatically qualified for Championship playoffs) will fill out the last two spots in Championship playoffs.
 - 5. The 8 teams in Championship playoffs will be split into 2 groups CCA and CCB (snaked) based on their PLAYOFF SEED as defined above and get a GROUP SEED based on the snake system. Each group will have a seed 1-4.
 - 6. Each team will play 3 games against teams from the other group, but not having the same GROUP SEED as them. Example: CCA1 will play CCB2, CCB3, CCB4; CCA2 will play CCB1, CCB3, CCB4 and so on. The team with the higher PLAYOFF SEED in each of these matchups are eligible for home field advantage.
 - 7. Team seeded 1 based on PLAYOFF SEED will start the playoffs with bonus points equivalent to the points for one win.
 - 8. Team seeded 2 based on PLAYOFF SEED will start the playoffs with bonus points equivalent to half the points for one win.
 - 9. After Championship playoffs have been completed, the teams will be ranked based on total points, NRR, Head to Head, League stage ranking and if everything is still tied, Coin toss. The total points will include points earned in playoff games and bonus points received (if applicable) based on above

- 10. Team finishing number 1 in Championship play-off will be declared as C-Division champions and team finishing with number 2 will be declared as C-Division Runners Up
- 11. Teams finishing 1 through 3 in the Championship play-off will be promoted to B-Division in the subsequent season. For that subsequent season, these 3 teams are ranked as the bottom most 3 teams in the B division by taking spots of team that relegated from B-division to C-division

3. C Division Ranking playoffs for 2025

- 1. Will be comprised of 8 teams
- 2. All 19 teams from C Division will be ranked from 1-19 based on points and NRR this will be their PLAYOFF SEED.
- 3. The two highest seeded remaining teams (other than the 6 that automatically qualified for Championship playoffs) will fill out the last two spots in championship playoffs.
- 4. Teams ranked 9 through 16 based on PLAYOFF SEED will qualify for the Ranking playoffs. These 8 teams in Ranking playoffs will be split into 2 groups CRA and CRB (snaked) based on their PLAYOFF SEED as defined above and get a GROUP SEED based on the snake system. Each group will have a seed 1-4.
- 5. Each team will play 3 games against teams from the other group, but not having the same GROUP SEED as them. Example: CRA1 will play CRB2, CRB3, CRB4; CRA2 will play CRB1, CRB3, CRB4 and so on. Match Secretaries will make best efforts to ensure that the team with the higher PLAYOFF SEED in each of these matchups will be eligible for home field advantage, but in some instances this may not be possible.
- 6. Team seeded 9 based on PLAYOFF SEED will start the playoffs with bonus points equivalent to the points for one win.
- 7. Team seeded 10 based on PLAYOFF SEED will start the playoffs with bonus points equivalent to half the points for one win.
- 8. After Ranking playoffs have been completed, the teams will be ranked based on total points, NRR, Head to Head, League stage ranking and if

everything is still tied, Coin toss. The total points will include points earned in playoff games and bonus points received (if applicable) based on above. This will be their final rank for the season.

4. Participation Playoffs for 2025

- 1. Will be comprised of 3 teams
- 2. All 19 teams from C Division will be ranked from 1-19 based on points and NRR this will be their PLAYOFF SEED.
- 3. The two highest seeded remaining teams (other than the 6 that automatically qualified for Championship playoffs) will fill out the last two spots in championship playoffs. Teams
- 4. Teams ranked 17 through 19 based on PLAYOFF SEED will qualify for the Participation playoffs. These 3 teams will be ranked CP1 through CP3 based on PLAYOFF SEED.
- 5. Each team will play against the other two teams in a round robin format totaling two games. The teams in Participation playoffs will only play 2 playoff games. Home field advantage will be given to higher ranked team based on PLAYOFF SEED where possible.
- 6. No bonus points will be given to teams in Participation playoffs
- 7. After Participation playoffs have been completed, the teams will be ranked based on total points, NRR, Head to Head, League stage ranking and if everything is still tied, Coin toss. The total points will only include points earned in playoff games. This will be their final rank for the season.

5. Playoff Forfeits

 Forfeits are not allowed in playoffs. If a team decides to forfeit a playoff game, normal forfeit rules will apply per Standing Rules – points, NRR and financial penalties.
