

General Guidelines for Season 2019

Hello NCCA Cricket Family,

As you all know, we are starting our 2019 season this weekend April 13th, 2019. We wanted to wish all the teams good luck for an excellent 2019 season ahead and wanted to share some key information for the team management and the captains. Please review the information carefully and let us know if you have any questions. Please do understand that this is just a cheat sheet for quick preview as you must adhere to standing rules and constitution.

- 4. Discipline: is the key success for the league. Any undesirable behavior brought to the attention of NCCA Executive or working committee will be forward to disciplinary committee and will do required steps.
- 5. Refer to the section 3.3.2.3 in Standing Rules on run rate calculation on partially played games.
- 6. Rescheduling reference refer section 3.8 in standing rule No rescheduling of games will be allowed unless it meets the criteria referred in section 3.8 of standing rule.
- Make sure to review and request an update to the Team Contacts to get NCCA notifications -There is a limit of 2 contacts per team limit. Send an email to the Match Secretaries to get this updated.



8. Responsibilities of home team:

The teams that did not have a home ground

- a. NCCA has assigned a ground for your team to play your home game if you did not have a NCCA approved ground
- b. In case of the ground availability issues, it is the responsibility of the home team to find an alternate NCCA approved ground
- c. Home Team needs to contact the ground owner and need to pay the ground fees to play in the ground. Home team may need to provide stumps, bails, cones, etc.

Ground assignments & fees

Teams that do not have a ground have been assigned a ground. Captain of the team needs to work closely with the owner of the ground regarding fees and if the ground availability changes, it is captains responsibility to identify another NCCA approved ground

Umpiring duty and penalties

- 1. Match Secretaries will send an email on a weekly basis with the schedule changes and any panel umpire assignments.
- 2. Review the email carefully and ensure to send the umpires for your games
- 3. Monetary fine and point penalty will be applied if you fail to send the umpires to fulfill your assignment. Refer to section 8.3 in Standing Rules
- ✓ Umpiring rule changes on leg umpire being uncertified. Refer to section 8.3.5 in Standing Rules
- ✓ Cricclub rules/ locking/ registration of players All request needs to be sending to Match Secretaries



Top 2 teams from each group will be eligible for play offs

✓ Group A1 vs Group B2 and Group B1 vs Group A2 will play in the semi finals

Playoff structure for premier divisions – Division Championship

- 1. Premier legal play off will follow IPL style Format
- 2. See below picture for format



Premier League Playoff Guideline on player eligibility

- ✓ Minimum 2 games to be played in the same team during the league games
- Player should be the tied player to that team (cannot play a tied player from other team in the same club)
